



We hope you have been growing, cooking and crafting, for the Village Show, and that you are looking forward to it as much as we are.

Here, we are providing information for you on how to enter and the rules for entry.

Tickets will be available on the day for purchase on the door. You'll need to buy a ticket for each class that you want to enter. Tickets are 30 pence per class and children are still free. Please remember, it is one class per household apart from children's entries which are one ticket per child. The classes are the numbered items in the schedule that you received in March. **Please note, we will only accept cash for tickets.** We would appreciate it if you could bring exact change.

If you are entering a sunflower (Nailstone residents only), someone will come to measure it between 24th and 30th August. You will need to email us at nailstonevillageshow@gmail.com before 24th August to arrange this. You will also need to pay 30 pence for your sunflower entry when it's measured.

If you need help getting to the venue then please let us know and we will arrange transport for you.

Refreshments and cakes will be available at the venue and there will be a tombola, **and even if you're not entering anything** you are still welcome to come for a chat, refreshments and to have a look at the exhibits. It will be great to see you.

Rules for entry

1. All exhibits to have been made or grown by Exhibitor.
2. Only one entry per household in each class is allowed.
3. Entries will not be allowed after the staging time.
4. For sunflower class, multiple sunflowers may be grown in your garden but only one entry per household. Sunflowers must be grown in Nailstone Parish.
5. Exhibits in Children's classes must bear a label stating the age of the child.
6. No exhibits can be removed before the end of the show at 3:00 pm.
7. All exhibits must be removed by 3:30 pm.
8. Nailstone Village Show organisers are not responsible for any losses or breakages.
9. There are no refunds on entry fees.
10. All children must be accompanied by a parent/guardian.
11. Only one "people's vote" per person.
12. THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL.
